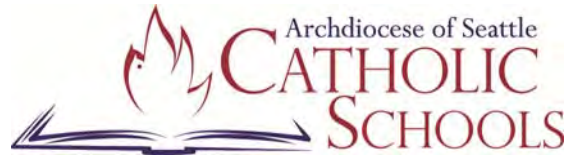

These self-reported statistics from each school community are valued and helpful for planning purposes. Confidential individual salary information for the principal, president, development director, and secretary is not included for full distribution in this publication.

Pastors and principals may request in writing a confidential datasheet that will show the specific salary information for their respective deanery only. Requests should be directed to the Superintendent of Catholic schools. Since it is self-reported data, this confidential information should be used only as a guide to planning.

The **electronic** version of the 2012-2013 School Data Report is where the **complete** dynamic and interactive NCEA report and longitudinal data is available for study. Printing and PDF capabilities are available. Principals/School Pastors have a private password on **SeeCelebrateandLive.org** to study the comprehensive 2012-2013 data collection that includes testing and assessment information, salary averages, and instructional materials that are being implemented in our 73 schools. We hope this body of information will provide each reader with robust information about our Catholic schools.

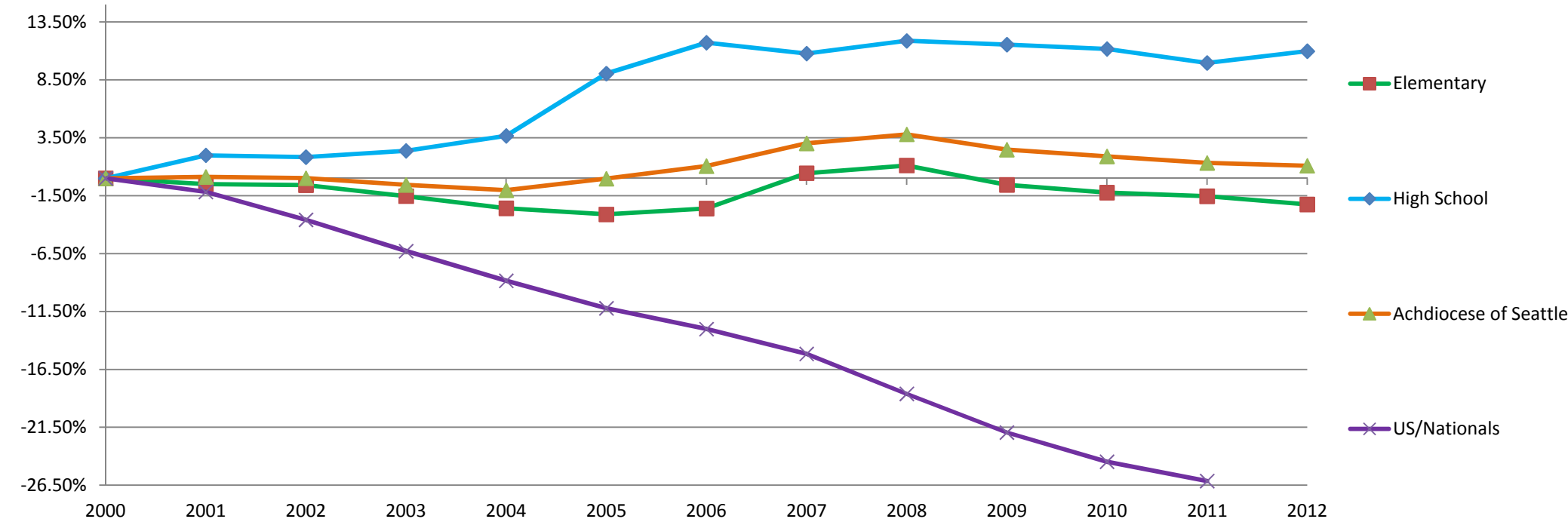

Chart of Percent Change in Total Enrollment 2000 - 2012



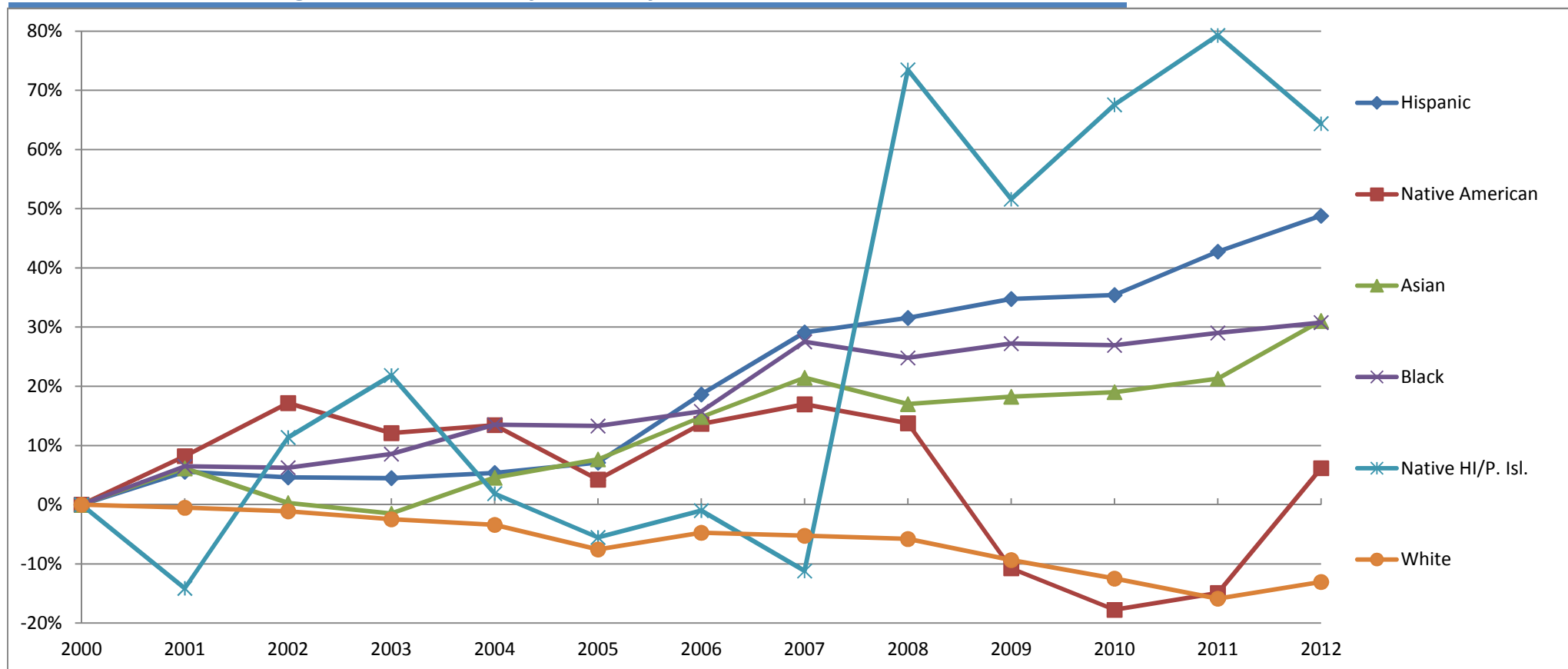
