From the Superintendent ...

I am looking forward to the opportunity to meet with our new school pastors this week. In preparation, I reread a Fr. Nuzzi's article titled, "[Why Catholic Education Still Matters in 10 Reasons](#)". Fr. Nuzzi captures so much about our schools in less than 1000 words.

Just last week, the words came to life for me and for the Kennedy Catholic High School staff, students and larger Catholic community. A beloved teacher, Mr. Jeff Behrends, passed from this life to the next during the school day, and truly, the experience magnified the holiness of our work. What could have been an insurmountable challenge became a very grace-filled day. All Saints Day Mass took on new meaning and became a time to be together in grief, and yet wrapped in our faith. Perhaps, we heard the words of the Eucharistic prayer a little differently, a little more vibrantly that day, "Remember also our brothers and sisters ...who have died in your mercy: welcome them into the light of your face. Have mercy on us all, we pray, that with the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God, with the blessed Apostles, and all the Saints who have pleased you throughout the ages, we may merit to be co-heirs to eternal life, and may praise and glorify you through your Son, Jesus Christ." We heard the familiar words at the end of the liturgy, "Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life." We are all called and sent to be the saints that our world needs right now. The care that I witnessed that day, from the school leaders, teachers, students, priests and representatives of the greater Catholic school community, testified to the importance of our work. Every day, every moment, becomes the opportunity to give new eyes to see the "footprints of God" and the daily Paschal Mystery present in every Catholic school.
