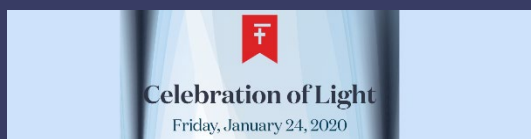
Cambodia is where I was born but here is where I call Home. I don't know if my job will be here when I return but if there is a position available within the Chancery, you will see me around.
