## Managing Stressed-Based Reactions in Catholic Schools

## **DETAILS:**

Educators often encounter unexpected challenges that disrupt their day — an unanticipated email, the need to repeat instructions multiple times, or learning about next year's teaching assignment and feeling less than enthusiastic. These moments can leave individuals feeling "thrown," a state that is becoming increasingly common, especially during high-stress times of the year.

Yet, these instances of being thrown present an opportunity to gain valuable insight into personal responses under pressure. Understanding when and why these reactions arise fosters greater self-awareness, enhances emotional intelligence, and strengthens personal accountability. By recognizing these triggers, individuals gain the ability to pause, assess, and intentionally choose their response, cultivating a sense of steadiness even in challenging circumstances.

On Wednesday, **March 26th**, Courtney Caldwell from the Henley Leadership Group — a former teacher and administrator in the Archdiocese of Seattle — will lead a session on identifying and managing stress-based reactions with compassion, humor, and kindness. This conversation will offer practical strategies to navigate stress while continuing the meaningful work of serving Catholic school students and the broader faith community.
